



Welcome and thank you for choosing Heroes United Golf Scramble League! Below you will find information to help you create the best opportunities and experience with our League.

WHAT TO BRING TO EVENTS (besides your golf gear)

Sunscreen
Water
Umbrella

215 pm Check in with registration table
230 pm Coach tip of the day (varies depending on the course & will be shared when you sign in)
245-330 pm Warm up on the range and putting green
345 pm Tee off

WHAT TO EXPECT

We will send out an email prior to each round of golf asking you to RSVP for each round of golf and dinner afterwards. Responding to this email helps us with planning, so please be on the lookout for this email and be sure to click on the links and reply.

Please plan to arrive at least 10 minutes before the event so you have time to chat with your new golf family! When you arrive at the course you'll park and look for the Heroes United Golf signs and/or flag. You'll check in with our registration table, sign in, pay your fees, sign your waiver (if you haven't already), and then head to the driving range where we'll have our coach tip of the day starting promptly at 230 pm. Afterwards you can proceed to warm up on the driving range and putting green as it works for you.

We will gather on the 1st tee around 340 pm and prepare to tee off at 345 pm. We will announce teams prior to the tee off time. You will then play 9 holes with your team and at least one person will keep score. During the round you will meet our coaches and volunteer staff who are there to remind you of the tip of the day, offer water, and maybe take a picture. Once you finish the round you will turn your scorecard into the registration table or staff person. You can either wait to see everyone finish, or you feel free to depart. First place team will be awarded a prize each round.

Points are accumulated and tallied each week, displayed in the newsletter, and prizes are awarded to every player at the end of the season banquet.

Afterwards we like to meet at a restaurant (locations vary) to chat and have fun. Those who choose to join us are responsible for their own meals.

Please see below for specific rules and scoring.

Rules of play

Teams are randomly mixed each round, unless you bring a guest who will be paired with you.

Women tee off from the forward tees.

Men tee off from the second set of tees.

Scramble format.

Every team must use at least one tee shot from each player during the round.

Season Point Scoring

Each round you will collect points based on your team's score.

Winning teams receive 5 points

2nd place team: 4 points

3rd place team: 3 points

4th place team: 2 points

5th (or higher) place team: 1 point

Tie scores will result in a putt-off for 1st place, with all team members participating.

At least one par 3 at each course will have a Closest to the Pin competition worth 5 additional points.

Bringing a friend to join or pay and play is worth 3 points each round (max 6 points per season)
