Follow-through. One of the most important things to remember when swinging from any distance is to remember that once you make contact, keep the club head moving through. Too often, especially with shorter shots, golfers tend to decelerate prior to, or once contact is made. This promotes a number of bad habits.

When you think about your follow through... practice it. We can't get better at a new skill unless we practice it. So, whether you're on the course with a club in hand or imagining the shot before you even step towards the ball think about what that follow through is going to look and feel like!
